

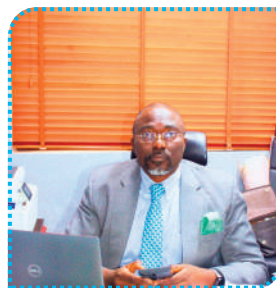

PenCom Secures Top Position Among 50 Regulatory Agencies



The National Pension Commission (PenCom) has achieved a significant milestone by securing the top position in the 2023 Ethics and Integrity Compliance Scorecard (EICS) among 50 regulatory agencies in Nigeria, according to an assessment by the Independent Corrupt Practices and Other Related Offences Commission (ICPC).

In the evaluation, PenCom also emerged the overall 14th position out of 404 Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDAs) on the comprehensive scorecard. Notably, PenCom achieved a commendable score, which was described by the ICPC as “substantial compliance”. The ICPC particularly commended PenCom for its well-established structures and processes that promote efficiency, while encouraging management to maintain high service delivery.

“The annual deployment of the Ethics and Integrity Compliance Scorecard by the ICPC aims to assess MDAs’ compliance with existing ethical, integrity, statutory, policy, and regulatory standards and practices. This initiative aligns with the Commission’s preventive mandate. The scorecard aims to minimise corruption risks, prevent system abuse, and revitalise ethics and integrity benchmarks in MDAs. The overarching objective is to ensure good service delivery while promoting a culture of ethical conduct within public service institutions.

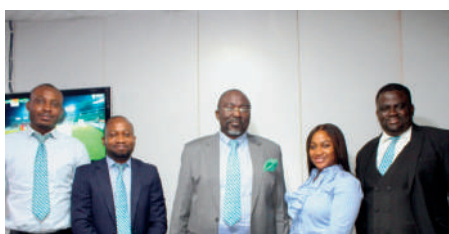

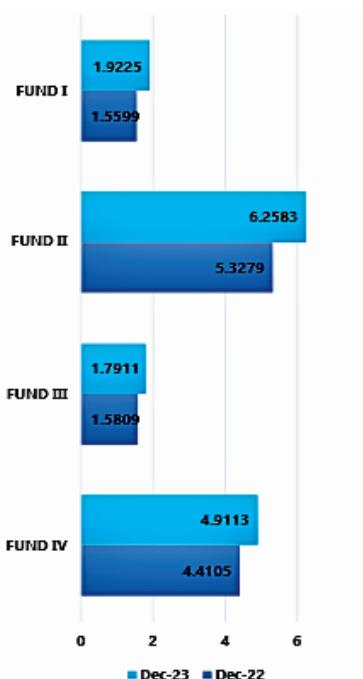
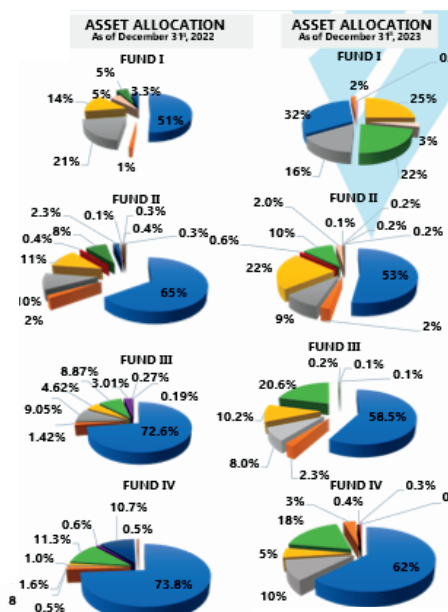
Investment Strategy

Headline Inflation Jumps to 28.92%.



The headline inflation rate rose to 28.92% y/y (+72bps) in December 2023, from 28.20% recorded in November 2023, due to a persistent rise in food and energy prices from the petrol subsidy removal, and volatility in the FX space. Food inflation grew by 109bps to 33.93% when compared to the previous month's rate, while Core inflation stood at 23.06% y/y. We anticipate a slowed pace of inflation due to expected accelerated tightening interventions by the CBN. Nonetheless, these expectations are barring any radical global/macroeconomic shifts and apex bank interventions.

Hiking is also a great way to meet new people and network, all I see is a win-win situation for all involved.

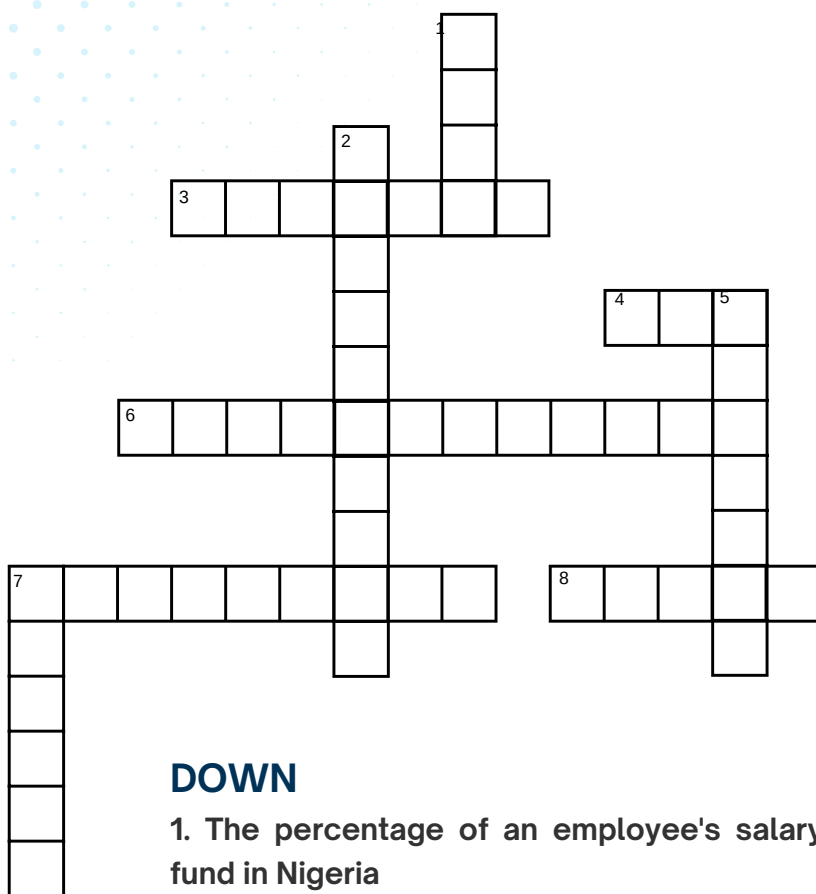

Osimhen cleared for Semi - Finals

- CAF

Good times for Super Eagles fans as the team has made it through to the 2023 AFCON quarter finals. Also, the star player, Victor Osimhen has been cleared alongside teammates Willian Troost-Ekong and Moses Simon following multiple doping tests by the Confederation of African Football (CAF) at the ongoing Africa Cup of Nations in Ivory Coast. His fitness and seemingly unending energy came under scrutiny due to his spectacular performance during the match against the Cameroon's Indomitable Lions on Saturday, 27th of January 2024.

Even though, most Nigerian fans were confident that Osimhen would pass the dope tests, it was still a huge relief and a cause for celebration after the results were released by CAF. The Napoli striker played a major role in the Super Eagles qualifications to the Semi Finals and was termed 'the beast'. He set up the first goal for Ademola Lookman and was a constant menace for the Cameroonians, before he was replaced

Osimhen scored the Eagles opening goal at the tournament in the 1-1 stalemate versus Equatorial Guinea and was fouled for the penalty that gave Nigeria a 1-0 win over Ivory Coast. In Nigeria's four games so far at the AFCON tournament, Osimhen played over 90 minutes in three games, while his lowest time on the pitch was 88 minutes in the game against Ivory Coast.

Nigerian fans took to social media platform, X, to hail the energetic striker amid the doping tests. The current CAF Player of The Year is expected to lead the line for the three-time champions when they face Angola in the quarterfinals on Friday.
